- The MPC identifies national best practices and leading-edge solutions to better serve beneficiaries. It monitors the health policy landscape to further identify emerging challenges in payment, service delivery, program administration and beneficiary access.
- Policy work is informed by both the empirical data available through Medicaid claims and other national and state data sources, as well as qualitative research from front-line, real-time service delivery providers and their clients.
- Beyond research and proposals, the MPC provides recurring services, such as data reporting and federal and state budget analysis.



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
