Donald Parker, MSW, President and CEO of Carrier Clinic. Given the great need for more mental health services in New Jersey, we reached out to an industry leader in New Jersey to address the issue in this Take Five interview.

Interview Sneak Peak: Can you share some of your ideas of how we can address the state's shortage of mental health providers?

First we need to expose medical students to the field and create financial incentives to those who go into psychiatric residency programs. We're doing that now with the Hackensack Meridian School of Medicine at Seton Hall University. The medical students who rotate through Carrier Clinic get significant exposure to the psychiatric field, as well as rotations through other parts of the psychiatric system in HMH. Secondly, if those students go into a residency...
