Christine Nazarenus is Chief Vision Officer and Co-Founder of <u>Medical Marijuana 411</u>, which provides online resources for medical cannabis education.

Interview Sneak Peak: Can you describe your work with Washington and Alaska to educate marijuana dispensary workers?

Washington State legalized recreational marijuana in 2012, but the state still wanted to focus on medicinal patients. So, the requirement would be that anyone working with medical patients within a dispensary had to be certified by a state-approved educational company...Medical Marijuana 411 was approved by the Washington Department of Health as one of three vendors permitted to offer the state required certification. We also are approved in Alaska to offer the state required Alaska Marijuana Handler's Card for any person involved in cannabis in Alaska. The requirements are slightly different in each state. We were approved for...
