- Leverage your purchasing power to structure value-based benefits and ask your health plan if they use Leapfrog data.
- Encourage hospitals in your network to participate in the Leapfrog Survey.

#### Legend:

- NTSV Caesarean (C) Section: First-time mothers giving birth to a single baby at 37 weeks or later in a head-down position. Leapfrog standard: 23.9% or lower.
- <u>Early Elective Delivery</u>: A scheduled medical induction or C-section performed without medical necessity prior to 39 weeks gestation. Leapfrog standard: 5% or lower.
- <u>Episiotomy</u>: An incision made in the perineum (birth canal) during childbirth. Leapfrog standard: 5% or lower.
- Red highlight indicates a hospital not meeting the Leapfrog standard for that measure.
