Frank Ghinassi is the President and CEO of University Behavioral Health Care at Rutgers Global Health Institute (Rutgers Health UBHC).

Interview Sneak Peek: How are you using performance measurement and feedback to keep improving quality?

We measure a wide variety of process and outcome indicators of health and wellness, along with the evidence base for and the adequacy of the "dose" of care. For example, what percentage of people are still coming to appointments after the initial diagnosis and treatment plan? Or, of people who start a medication, say treatment for depression, how many are still taking and refilling their medication in six months? We may use a depression inventory or an anxiety inventory to track the degree of change and /or severity of your symptoms. We are focused on measuring your functional effectiveness, as in how well are you engaging in work, school, and social activities?
