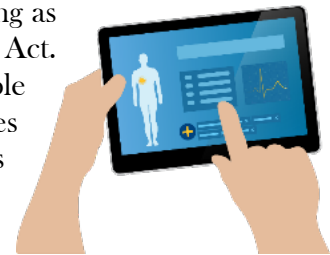

COVID-19 Telehealth Reimbursement Program for Eligible Nonprofit and Certain Public Health Care Providers

Reimbursement, through the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), is available for eligible health care providers that purchased telehealth services after March 13, 2020.

The COVID-19 Telehealth Program will provide \$200 million in funding as part of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. The COVID-19 Telehealth Program will provide funding for eligible providers' telecommunications services, information services, and devices necessary to provide critical connected care services until the program's funds have been expended or the COVID-19 pandemic has ended. Up to \$1 million per provider will be awarded. In addition, COVID-19 Telehealth Program support may be available for services that require monthly recurring charges, such as broadband connectivity or remote patient monitoring services, through September 30, 2020.



How to Apply:

1. **Determine Eligibility:** Obtain an eligibility determination from the Universal Service Administrative Company for each health care provider site included on their application. This can be obtained by completing FCC Form 460: <https://www.usac.org/rural-health-care/resources/forms/>.
2. **Get a Registration Number:** Obtain an FCC Registration Number through the online portal. The FCC will release a Public Notice and post information about the web address and opening date for that portal on the Commission's Keep Americans Connected page: <https://www.fcc.gov/keep-americans-connected>.
3. **Register:** Register with Commission Registration System (CORES) for Award Management at: <https://apps.fcc.gov/cores/userLogin.do>.
4. **Apply:** Complete the application.
