Calvin H. Knowlton, BScPharm, Ph.D., is the Founder and CEO of Tabula Rasa HealthCare, a long-time member of the Quality Institute's Purchaser Council. The company provides patient-specific, data-driven technology to optimize medication regimens.

<u>Interview Sneak Peek:</u> As a leader in medication safety, what have you discovered about the risk of adverse drug events associated with drugs repurposed for the treatment of COVID-19?

...We looked at an older group of people about 75 years old with 10 comorbidities. We found that when you add repurposed drugs for COVID you may fix COVID, but it adds a lot more risk to the patient. We didn't give the meds to anybody. We simulated adding these drugs to analyze what would happen. And so I think it's an eye opener.
