# **EDUCATION**

- Hosted virtual learning opportunities for members and the public throughout the year on topics ranging from telehealth to advance care planning to reproductive health access.
- Created the following <u>resources</u> to help Quality Institute members navigate their pandemic response:
  - 1. <u>Mayors Wellness Campaign A Call for Community Action</u>
  - 2. Supporting New Jerseyans in Need of Healthcare Coverage

- In partnership with the New Jersey Reproductive Health Access Project Steering Committee, the Quality Institute developed and disseminated the New Jersey Reproductive Health Access Project (NJ-RHAP) Provider Access Commitment Toolkit and 10 additional resources. These materials support providers (clinical and administrative) in better understanding policies and best practices for comprehensive and quality contraceptive care. Topics range from effective billing and coding and contraceptive counseling to community engagement strategies.



# **POLICY**

<u>Medicaid Policy Center (MPC)</u>: Received the <u>Integrated Care for Kids (InCK)</u> cooperative agreement from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). We serve as a co-lead organization, alongside <u>Hackensack Meridian Health (HMH)</u> and the Visiting <u>Nurse Association (VNA) of Central Jersey</u> to test an Alternative Payment Model (APM), for NJ Family Care programs, by providing payment for screening and provision of integrated community-based core child health services.

As a response to the steep decline in enrollment for New Jersey's small group market in recent years, the Quality Institute
convened subject matter experts and thought leaders to develop short-term and long-term solutions to stabilize the current
market and address related overall affordability and coverage issues. As a result of this work, the Quality Institute released
Short and Long-Term Strategies to Support Health Care Affordability and Price Transparency for Small Employers and
Consumers in New Jersey, a white paper providing background on the market and proposed solutions to improve its viability.

# **COMMUNITY HEALTH**

# Mayors Wellness Campaign (MWC):

- 1. Published the Mayors Wellness Campaign (MWC) Handbook to help Mayors develop or grow their MWC program. The handbook includes instructions to start a MWC program, an annual checklist to guide activities, resources to help conduct a health needs assessment, a press toolkit, and guidance to plan, implement, and evaluate programs. The 2020 Edition of the MWC Handbook was generously sponsored by <a href="The Russell Berrie-Foundation">The Russell Berrie-Foundation</a>.
- 2. Hosted focus groups in all 21 counties with over 75 mayors participating along with Public Health Officers and many volunteers to gain an understanding about MWC programming best practices and challenges during the pandemic.

# Conversation of Your Life (COYL):


- 1. Partnered with the State Health Benefits Program to provide crucial advance care planning information to State employees and their family members using COYL workshops and other resources.
- 2. As COYL continues to expand we want to ensure the program is culturally sensitive and incorporates New Jersey residents of all cultures in these important conversations. Therefore, we introduced COYL programming in languages other than English to meet the needs of the diverse residents of New Jersey. Programs have since been held for Hispanic, Korean, Chinese, Polish, and Urdu communities in their native language. We have also introduced programming to the Veteran community and continue to incorporate other diverse communities in New Jersey.



# **QUALITY IMPROVEMENT**

- Became the <u>Leapfrog Group</u> Regional Leader for the State of New York. We also proudly supported our New Jersey hospitals to achieve 100% participation in the <u>Leapfrog Group's annual Hospital Survey</u>.
- Published <u>Quality Briefings</u> to educate members on the <u>Leapfrog Group Top Hospital Best Practices</u> and <u>Early Elective Deliveries</u>.
- At the request of the State and several foundations, we convened and led the Perinatal Care During COVID-19
   Workgroup, which included many of our members, and released <u>Recommendations for Perinatal Care During</u>
   <u>COVID-19</u>, which were incorporated into the New Jersey Department of Health's (NJDOH) guidance to hospitals and health care providers.
- We joined Rutgers Project ECHO to actively recruit nursing homes in New Jersey to join an interactive training
  program to advance improvements in COVID-19 preparedness, safety and infection control, and nursing home
  resilience. In partnership with the NJ Department of Health, <u>Robert Wood Johnson Medical School</u>, and <u>Trinitas Regional Medical Center</u> and subject matter experts from around the state, <u>Project ECHO</u> will deliver a year-long
  program of classes and quality consultation.

# **LOOKING AHEAD**



We have been awarded the Maternal Health Innovation Program grant from the New Jersey Department of Health (NJDOH) to increase awareness of the Recommendations for Perinatal Care During COVID-19 among New Jersey residents, with a special focus on vulnerable populations.

Our Mayors Wellness Campaign will release a Reducing Social Isolation Toolkit, generously funded by Amerigroup, to help towns create a volunteer-based match program to connect older adults who are experiencing social isolation to a member of their community.





We have partnered with BioNJ, the life sciences trade association in New Jersey to create the multi-stakeholder *Lessons from COVID-19 Work Group*. The work group will release an actionable report that identifies our strengths, examines our weaknesses, and offers best practices along with consensus recommendations to guide State and federal health policy leaders in addressing regulatory and process issues.
