The <u>National Academies of Sciences Engineering Medicine</u> (National Academies) released, <u>Implementing High-Quality Primary Care: Rebuilding the Foundation of</u> <u>Health Care</u>, a comprehensive report that outlines primary care's positive effects on society. The report sets forth a five-part implementation plan that includes a mechanism for every person in the nation to choose or be assigned a primary care practice that offers on-going primary and preventive care...






