Focus of the Month: Build Your Implementation Team

- Unit nursing leaders
- Obstetrical care providers (midwives, physicians)
- Charge nurses, Staff nurses
- Data/quality specialists
- Project managers/coordinators
- Patient/family representatives
- Clinicians intermittently throughout the life of the project (anesthesiologists, neonatologists, pediatricians, childbirth educators, residents, office practice leaders)

Next Steps: Before our next coaching call, complete the following activities with your implementation team:

• Determine your implementation leaders

•

- Executive Leader, Nurse Leader, Physician Leader, etc.
- Determine time and cadence for internal implementation team meetings.
- Determine the number of shared planning boards needed (how many rooms on units) and consider board placement.
 - We recommend 2' by 3', vertical or horizontal.
 - Determine number of clinicians you have per unit (triage, labor and delivery, postpartum) o Nurses, Midwives, Physicians
