



TeamBirth NJ Collaborative Session Handout #6 - August 2023

In this session, we focused on best practices, preparing for launch, and patient surveying.

Continue training sessions to educate the full department on the new process. Training should include both education and scenario-based simulations. **Use small scale-testing** to determine how TeamBirth can be effectively integrated into the processes in your unit. Set your teams up for success by intentionally deciding when key decision making huddles should be occurring, particularly in postpartum, and communicate that expectation to staff.

Continue to work with site leadership to **plan a launch event** that creates an atmosphere of excitement around the project and sets the expectation that every staff member will begin to use the solution going forward, that their voice is important, and that feedback to the implementation team regarding opportunities and successes is expected.
