WHAT'S A MIDWIFE?



“Midwives are licensed health care providers who offer a wide range of essential reproductive and sexual health care services, from birth and newborn care to Pap tests and contraceptive care.” *Commonwealth fund (2023)*



BENEFITS OF MIDWIVES

➤ **Reduced Maternal Mortality and Morbidity**

➤ **Decreased c-section rates**

➤ **Improved respect and patient autonomy**

Protection of normal physiological birth

➤ **Address gap in OB providers**



BRIEF HISTORY

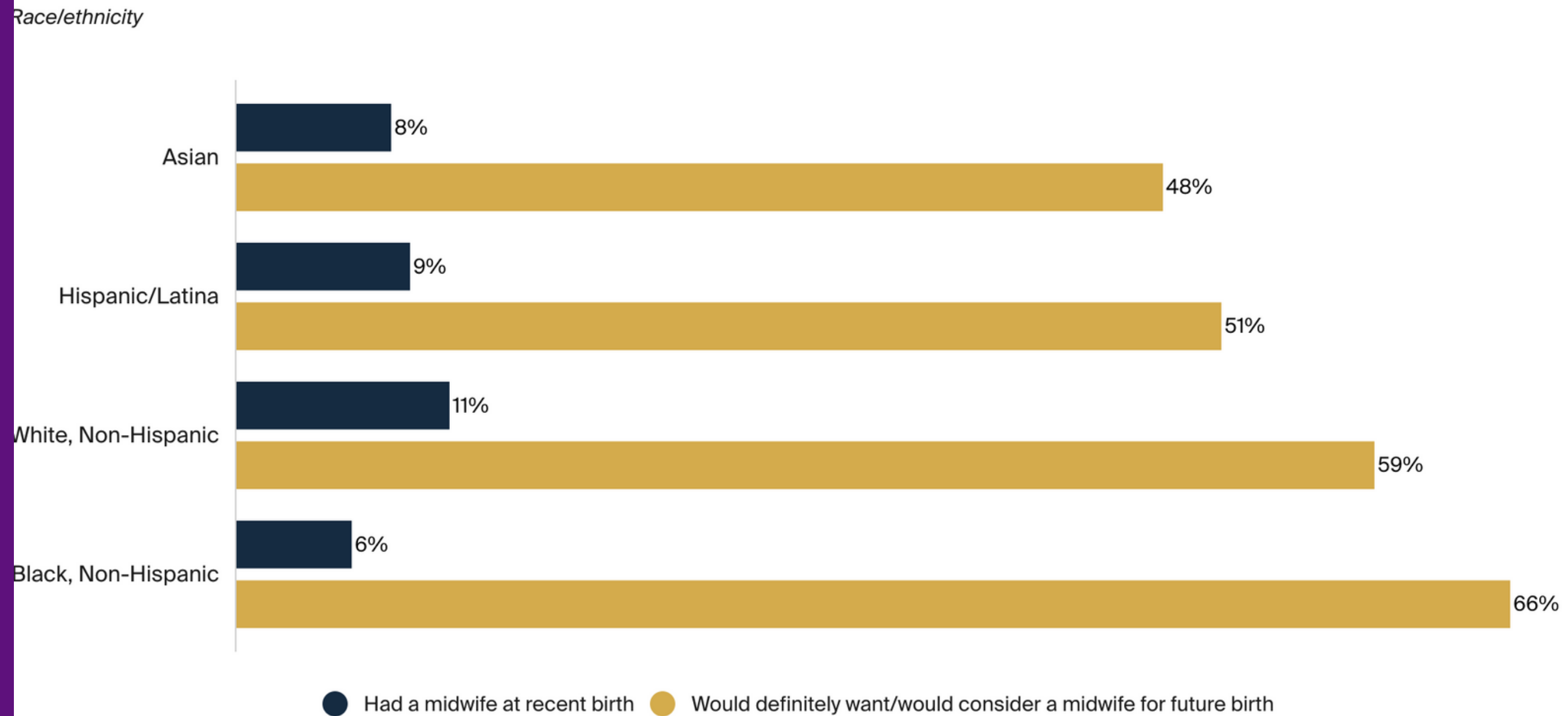


- Granny Midwives brought the practice of traditional midwifery from West Africa
- White men took an interest in Midwifery and launch the field of obstetrics in the 1800s
- Granny midwives continued to do black births and the practice became criminalized (Unclean)
- Licensure was launched as a form of gate keeping
- Black midwives were blamed for maternal and infant death
- Hospital births were incentivized
- Workforce of midwives declined
- 80% of Black births were attended by midwives in the 1930's, compared to only 9% in 2020.

CURRENT LANDSCAPE OF MIDWIFERY

- 95% of all midwives work in a hospital setting
- Three types of midwives
 - certified nurse-midwives (CNMs),
 - certified midwives (CMs)
 - certified professional midwives (CPMs)
- Lack of full practice autonomy
- Midwives are not fully accessible to all
- 90% of U.S. midwives identify as white/non-Hispanic
- Inequitable Medicaid reimbursement rates

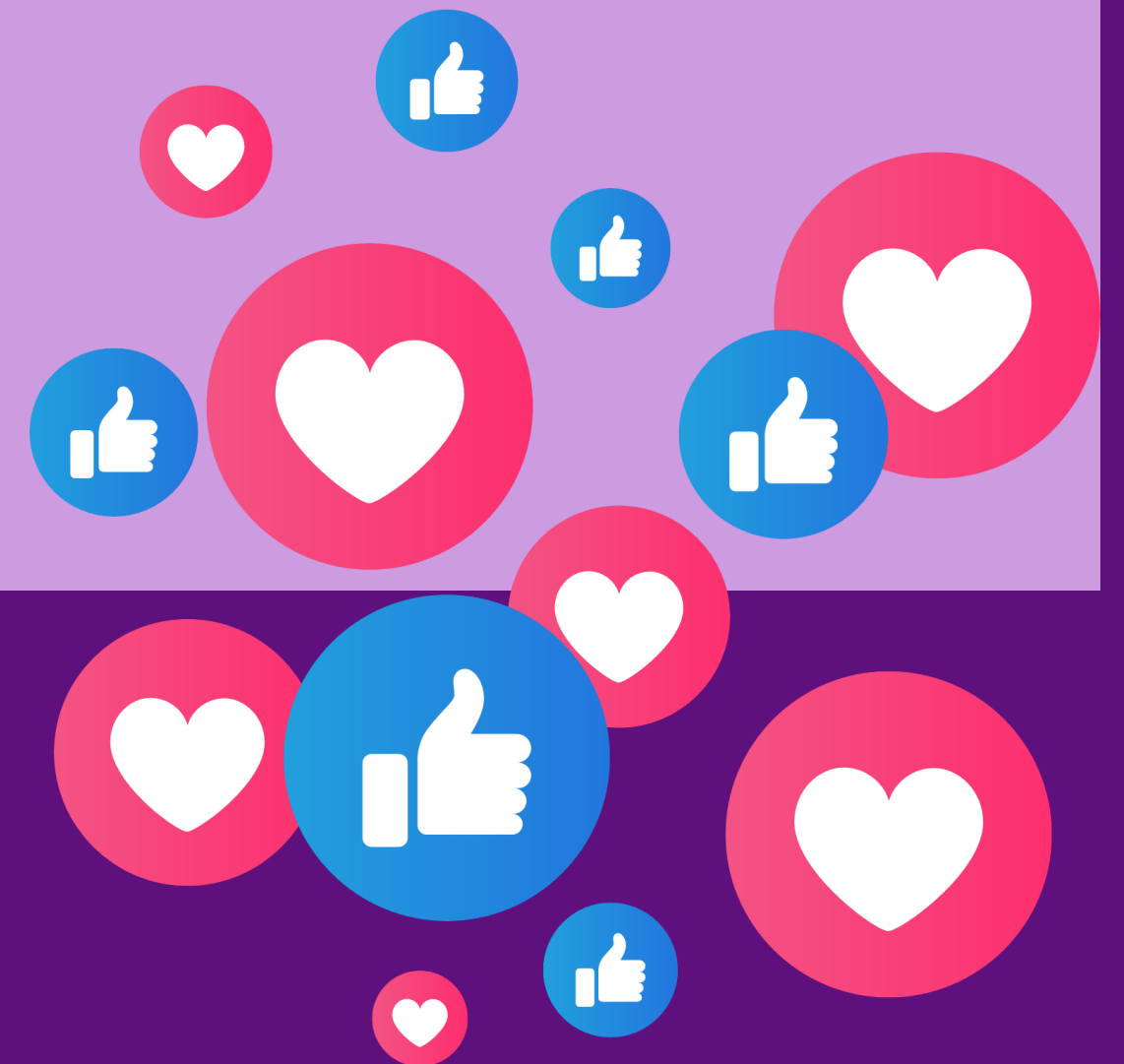
