OUR WORK



POLICY

- Advanced the <u>Maternity Action Plan</u> ("MAP"), a holistic approach to combatting maternal
 mortality and morbidity. The MAP provides a directional path forward in four critical ways
 to address New Jersey's maternal health crisis and eliminate disparities: Community Social
 Supports, Workforce, Payment, and Data. This work is supported by <u>Robert Wood Johnson</u>
 <u>Foundation</u>.
- Implemented year four of NJ Integrated Care for Kids (NJ InCK) in partnership with NJ FamilyCare, Hackensack Meridian *Health*, and the Visiting Nurse Association of Central New Jersey. InCK employs community-based case management and screening for children and families who are at the highest risk for health complexity. This work is supported by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS).

- Worked to amplify the <u>Delivering Better Care: Midwifery Practice in New Jersey</u> report, through the <u>Maternal Infant Health (MIH) Hub</u>, a policy and learning collaborative created to strengthen midwifery practice and promote birth equity and justice in New Jersey. This work is supported by <u>The Burke Foundation</u>.
- Implemented year two of the <u>NJ FamilyCare Perinatal Episode of Care Pilot</u>. As a member of the Pilot Steering Committee, provided guidance to participating providers to improve the quality and equity of perinatal care.
- Convened multidisciplinary teams focused on mapping the long-term sustainability of innovative models of care like HealthySteps, CenteringPregnancy and CenteringParenting. This work is supported by the <u>New Jersey American Academy of Pediatrics</u>.
- Updated the <u>New Jersey Reproductive Health Access Project Provider Access (NJ-RHAP) Toolkit</u>.
- Provided recommendations in the <u>White Paper on Short-and-Long-Term Solutions to Improve the Small Employer Insurance Market</u>, that were included in legislation Governor Murphy signed, A4294/S2824 and A5137/S3480, to improve New Jersey's small group health insurance market.
- Co-led the <u>Essential Jobs Essential Care (EJEC) coalition</u> to support and grow the direct care workforce. This work stems from the <u>Guidance Document to Recruit, Train, and Retain a Resilient and Diverse Health Care Workforce for New Jersey report. This work is supported by <u>The Henry and Marilyn Taub Foundation</u>.</u>



COMMUNITY HEALTH

- Mayors Wellness Campaign (MWC):
 - Hosted a workshop focused on <u>data-informed community health</u> to explore best practices using local data to inform programming. This work is supported by <u>Fidelis Care NJ</u>.
- Provided six Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) training courses to 77 community partners.
 During MHFA trainings participants learn how to assist someone experiencing a mental health crisis and where to turn for professional help. This work is supported by The Horizon Foundation for New Jersey.
- Awarded \$127,500 to 10 Mayors Wellness Campaign committees throughout New Jersey to support local programs focused on addressing mental health. This work is supported by the Walmart Foundation.

Conversation of Your Life (COYL):


• Developed and updated COYL resources including community messaging toolkits, COYL bookmarks, Media Clubs and the <u>COYL toolkit</u>. These tools equip partners and community leaders to both facilitate meaningful programs as well as raise awareness about end-of-life topics. This work is supported by the <u>The Y.C. Ho/Helen & Michael Chiang Foundation</u>.



QUALITY IMPROVEMENT

- Expanded <u>TeamBirth NJ</u> to include 4 additional hospital sites: Saint Peter's University Hospital and Mary V O'Shea Birth Center, Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital, and Virtua Mount Holly. This program is designed to improve patient and provider communications and thereby improve maternal and infant health outcomes and reduce inequities. We partner with Ariadne Labs and are supported by the <u>New Jersey Department of Health</u>.
- Created a program to provide Perinatal Mental Health First Aid, which was approved for national use and provided trainings for over 175 doulas and other perinatal communitybased participants. This work is supported by the <u>Healthcare Foundation of New Jersey</u>.
- Achieved the highest participation rate in the country on the <u>Leapfrog Group's Annual Hospital Survey</u>.
- Released two <u>Quality Briefings</u>: one explaining the different health care ratings systems and another sharing best practices and tools for clinicians to use to return to pre-pandemic levels of preventive care.


