



## TeamBirth NJ Collaborative Session Handout #4 - April 2024

In this session, we focused on the Engage and Coach section of the implementation pathway. In this phase, we discussed small scale testing and training your staff and providers, as well as preparing for launch.

## **Key Ideas:**

- **Champions** are an integral part of TeamBirth implementation. By offering leadership, education, and project support, as well as TeamBirth socialization and coaching, champions help to ensure that TeamBirth is a success.
- **TeamBirth Core and Adaptable Components** help you identify TeamBirth components that must be done as well as parts you can adapt to meet the needs of your staff and patients. Review as a team!
- **Training Videos** -Begin to send out training videos now, to give staff and providers baseline knowledge of the project ahead of training that will take place in the summer.
- **Discussion guides** help support huddles and decisions around admission, labor support tools, or assisting births with instruments or surgery. Review as a team!
