Special Edition Take Five Interview on Linda Schwimmer on Her 10-Year Anniversary as the President & CEO of the New Jersey Health Care Quality Institute

<u>Interview Sneak Peek:</u> You just marked ten years as President and CEO of the Quality Institute. With a background in law, health insurance, and government, what inspired you to join the Quality Institute, and what continues to motivate you today?

The Quality Institute excels in two areas critically important to me: connecting people and making things better. When my predecessor and friend Dave Knowlton approached me about coming to the Quality Institute, he asked, "How'd you like to have the best job in health care?" A good opener. But what closed the deal for me was my own interactions with the Quality Institute when I worked in the legislative and executive branches of State government and, later, in the health insurance industry. I knew being CEO of the Quality Institute was an enviable job, focused on improving health care for everyone — not just one sector or group. And most importantly, I could spend my time making a difference in people's lives. That goal drew me to the Quality Institute and keeps me motivated today.

Looking back over the past decade, what accomplishments of the Quality Institute are you most proud of?

First, I am proud of my hard-working, dedicated, and talented team. Everyone tells me what a great team I have and they are right.

I'm also proud that the Quality Institute has taken on challenges that span the entire lifespan, from birth through the end of life. We champion care that is safe, respectful, not over-medicalized — and that is responsive to what truly matters to people. I wish we could claim more success on strengthening primary care, but I am not giving up.
